A selection of white wines made from traditional Italian grapes grown in the Bridgehampton vine-yards is unique to the area and probably the country. The tastes are spectacular, expressive of the grape, the soil, and the winemaker's skills. Quantities are very limited and demand keeps building, so when you are served one of these wines, be grateful. Tracy also conducts occasional wine classes where he shares his considerable knowledge.
